Yowlumne Yokuts (Penutian, spoken in California)

Yokuts was spoken around Kern Lake in the Central Valley (near Bakersfield). There are three main branches of Yokuts with dozens of identified varieties. Only a few are still spoken today. Yowlumne (or Yawelmani) belongs to the Southern Valley branch; speakers currently reside on or near the Tule River Reservation at the edge of the Sequoia National Forest.
